

DNA Testing

DNA typing of the sire, dam and foal is required through the University of Kentucky for a foal to be registered. The procedure is to send this DNA Testing form with the hair sample of the foal (make sure that the sire and dam are already in the data base) and send check to the registrar. The Registrar then sends the sample to UK and they return a report to the registrar. If requested, a copy of that report is sent to the owner of the pony. The registrar can only send the report to the pony's owner. The sire and dam of a foal must have been DNA typed through the University of Kentucky for that foal to be registered in the DPRA studbook.
